Description

Samba rock imported from Japan. Unique, natural piece with beautiful veining. This rock is commonly used in the creation of Japanese gardens, including chaniwa, tea gardens, or strolling gardens. This model, featuring a central hole that retains water, is one of the elements of a tsukubai and is called shozubachi. It is often topped with a bamboo spout that gently pours water, creating an overflow in a simple closed-loop system. External dimensions: 840 x 500 mm Height: 450 mm Central hole dimensions: approximately Ø 280 x 250 mm, 100 mm deep Approximate weight: 400 ± kg To highlight the beauty of its green veins nuanced with white, the rock was moistened for the photograph, showcasing its full splendor.
